## a. Green Revolving Fund Policies & Administrative Guidelines – 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading

Dr. Spann completed the 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading of the Green Revolving Fund Policies & Administrative Guidelines.

# b. GeNET Classes – Creative Writing & World Mythology

Mr. Lindhurst submitted the paperwork for the Proposed Course Adoption of Creative Writing & World Mythology. Both classes would be electives for 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> grade students. A survey of high school students showed 44 were interested in Creative Writing and 60 in World Mythology.

# c. MS Flooring Estimate - \$46,640

This MS flooring estimate is on the high side. Dr. Spann explained that approving this estimate of at or below \$46,640 will help keep the project on target to be completed prior to the start of the school year. Ty Burt suggested we not use DF Flooring for this project because of past work done in the District.

## d. Site & Building Update

Several BOE members, John Beyette, Kristy Spann and Dale Bednarski participated in a walk thru at Barhitte and the MS to create a punch list of items that need to be completed. Additional rebates are available prior to June 30th. They will do a walk thru at the HS tomorrow at 10:00 a.m.
